FUNERAL OF RUFUS LITCHFIELD

The last rites were said over the remains of Rufus Litchfield at his late residence, 185 Schermerhorn street, yesterday afternoon at 2 o'clock. A large number of friends and business acquaintances of the deceased were present, beside many members of the Universalist Church of Our Father, with which Mr. Litchfield had been connected for years. Rev. J. Coleman Adams, the pastor of All Souls' Universalist church in the eastern district, officiated. The denominational funeral service was read, after which the eulogy was delivered by Mr. Adams. Rev. R. A. White of Newtonville, Mass., offered a fervent prayer.
