Bouckville—Mrs. Elizabeth P. Livermore, 89 years old, died in Faxton Hospital at Utica Saturday evening, May 13, where she had been confined after a seven months' illness with a broken hip. She was born in Solsville, July 8, 1854, daughter of James H. and Renette Phelps Parker, and had lived in this community her entire life. She married Newton Livermore Oct. 30, 1877. He died 21 years ago this month. She was a member of the Madison Universalist Church. Surviving is one son, James M. Livermore; four grandchildren, Mrs. Frank Stone of Hamilton, and William [and] Leon Livermore of Bouckville, and Benjamin Livermore of Oriskany Falls; also six great-grandchildren. Funeral services were held at the home of her son at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday with Dr. Lynn Booth of Utica officiating. Burial in Madison.
