FRED G. LOCKE

Fred G. Locke, aged 89, of Fly Creek, R.D., died Thursday at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Dale Houghtaling of Fly Creek, R.D., after a long illness.

He was born March 20, 1871, in Prey Hill, Town of Richfield, the son of Ainsley and Elizabeth (Getman) Locke. He attended Brighton schools. He married Nellie Fay on March 23, 1898, in Richfield Springs. She died December 30, 1945. Mr. Locke taught school in Bloodgood many years ago. He was a retired farmer.

He was a member of the [former] Richfield Springs Universalist Church.

Surviving are his daughter; a son, Norman Locke of Fly Creek Valley; four grandchildren; five great-grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held at 3 p.m. on Saturday from the Ingalls Funeral Home in Cooperstown, with the Rev. William Highfield, pastor of the First Methodist Church of Cooperstown, officiating. Burial will be in Fly Creek Cemetery later in the spring.
