Elizabeth Garner Lockwood, widow of the late Benona Lockwood, died at her home in this village on Friday afternoon, November 4th, death being due to a cold contracted three weeks previous. The funeral was held at the residence on Monday afternoon at two o'clock, the Reverend H. W. Crydenwise of St. John's Church officiating, and interment was made in Lakeview Cemetery.

Mrs. Lockwood was the daughter of Peter and Lavina Garner and was born in the town of Warren on March 10, 1843. On December 31, 1857, she married Benona Lockwood, who died November 7, 1915. Fifty years of her life had been spent in this village. Mrs. Lockwood was a member of the Universalist Church. There survive two sons and a grandson, Emory and Ward Lockwood, and Charles E. Lockwood; also a brother, Albert Garner, of Salt Springville.
