ALICE LOOMIS

Miss Alice Loomis passed away Friday, April 26, 1940 at the home of Mrs. Edith Greene, in Herkimer, where she had been cared for several years. She had been an invalid for a long time, and a patient sufferer.

Miss Loomis was born on the old Loomis farm, south of this village, Nov. 26, 1860, a daughter of Daniel and Sybil Loomis. Her entire life had been spent in Richfield. She was a member of the Universalist Church and attended when her health would permit. She received her education at the Goodier Seminary in Richfield Springs, and taught in the rural schools where she was very successful. She had been a member of Ganowauges Chapter, D.A.R.

She leaves a sister, Mrs. Carrie Beadle of Richfield, and two brothers, Cecil Loomis of Rome and Leland Loomis of Brighton.

The funeral was held Sunday at the home of Howard Beadle in Richfield Springs at 3 p.m., The Reverend Charles Kramer of Cooperstown officiating. Burial was made in the family lot at Twilight Rest Cemetery, Richfield.
