MRS. DAISY T. LOVELL DIES AT EDWARDS Was Born in Canton Near Eddy

Mrs. Daisy Taylor Lovell, a native of Canton, but a resident of Edwards for some years past, died at her home at Edwards Friday evening after a brief illness.

Mrs. Lovell was the widow of Dr. Frederic S. Lovell, a member of St. Lawrence University, Class of 1885, and a graduate of N.Y. University, 1886, and later a student in Berlin, Germany, University.

Funeral services were conducted Monday from the home in Edwards and burial will take place in the spring in Evergreen Cemetery, Canton.

Mrs. Lovell, who was born at Eddy, formerly old Jerusalem Corners, was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. James Taylor of that locality. She was one of a family of several children. The old Taylor farm is still in the family, occupied by a brother, George W. Taylor and his family. She attended the Jerusalem Corner School and Canton Village School. On Feb. 17, 1921, she married Dr. Frederick S. Lovell at Philadelphia, Pa. Her husband, Dr. Lovell, who was born in Canton on the old DeKalb Road, was a noted eye, ear and throat specialist and was associated professor Laryng. and Physiology of New York P. G. Med. School, Prof. of Rhinology [sic] and Laryng., New York Polyclinic Med. School and Hospital, and consulting Ryngologist [sic] Bronx Eye, Ear and Throat Hospital and St. Catherine's Hospital, Brooklyn.

Dr. Lovell practiced his profession in New York City until he retired on account of his health. The couple came to Edwards to live.

This was the home for many years, and at the time of Dr. Daniel M. Taylor, a brother of Mrs. Lovell. Dr. Lovell died Feb. 9, 1929.

Mrs. Lovell was a member of the Universalist Church of Edwards and the Order of Eastern Star.

She is survived by one brother, George W. Taylor; three nephews, Donald W. Taylor, Canton, Dr. Irving W. Taylor, Massena, and John Day, Cleveland, O; a niece, Mrs. Mary Drillien, Hempstead, L.I.; and a step-daughter, Mrs. Charles F. (Gladdeus Lovell) Murphy, Mamaroneck, L.I.

Mrs. Lovell was about 75 years old.
