AVERY T. LOW

Central Square, N.Y.—Avery T. Low, sixty-nine years old and a prominent business man, who died at his home in this village last night, will be buried on Friday.

Mr. Low had been in the mercantile business in this village for forty-four years and was postmaster several times. He was a veteran of the Civil War, enlisting in the 110th New York Volunteers, as a private at the age of twenty years, rising to the rank of adjutant.

Besides being a member of the G.A.R. he had been an active Mason forty-four years, holding the office of worshipful master several times. He had also been a supervisor and served on the Board of Education.

He was president of the First Universalist Society and vice President of the Cayuga Universalist Association.
