She brought successive classes into the church well grounded in the faith. She was a lover and student of birds and flowers. She had a remarkable gift of song with a voice of splendid range and sweetness. She left a bequest of two thousand five hundred dollars to the local church. Among other beneficiaries of her will are the Chapin Home [in New York City], Doolittle Home for the Aged [in Philadelphia], the Eastern Long Island Hospital and the [NY State Convention of Universalists] Pension Fund.
