Mrs. Anna Lown died at the home of her son, S. R. Lown, just North of this village, Thursday, May 20th, at 3 o'clock A.M. Deceased maiden name was Miss Anna Abbott and she was born Nov. 22nd, 1815, in this town. She was married to S. B. Lown in 1835, and they were blest with three daughters and one son. Two daughters and her husband preceeded her to the other shore, the latter having died in 1876. She leaves to mourn her loss besides a daughter, Mrs. Scott of Canandaigua, and her son, S. R. Lown, two sisters and one brother. Both Mr. and Mrs. Lown were members of the Universalist church. She was a noble Christian woman, and when the end came she was thoroughly prepared to go. The funeral was held at the residence of S. R. Lown last Saturday at 11 o'clock, Rev. P. P. Carroll, pastor of the M. E. church, officiating. A large number of friends were in attendance to pay a last tribute of respect and love to one who through a long life proved herself worthy of the esteem and confidence of all.
