Fred J. Ludemann

Fred J. Ludemann, 78, 11 Scott, vicepresident [sic] of the Eureka Mower Co., who retired five years ago, died Nov. 30, 1943, in a local hospital after an illness of three years.

He was born in Hamburg, Germany, Aug. 10, 1865, and came to this country at the age of 2. He had lived in Utica or more than 35 years and traveled about 33 years in 20 states for the mower firm. He attended the Universalist Church.

On June 7, 1893 he married May K. Babcock of Babcock Hill, who survives. They celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary last June. He also leaves two sons, Arthur B. Ludemann, Brooklyn, and John H. Ludemann, Utica; also two grandchildren in Brooklyn and a brother, Herman S. Ludemann, Syracuse.

The funeral will be at 2 p.m. tomorrow from the home with interment in Fairview Cemetery near Bridgewater.
