Mrs. Amy Farnam Lyon, aged 68, wife of Clarence Lyon, of 126 East Eighteenth street, a resident of the Eastern District for many years, died Monday after a long illness. The funeral services this evening will be conducted by the Rev. Dr. A. Eugene Bartlett, pastor of All Souls Universalist Church. The interment tomorrow will be in Cypress Hills Cemetery. Mrs. Lyon was the daughter of the late Joel B. and Amy Farnam and was born in the Thirteenth Ward of old Williamsburgh and later lived many years in the Nineteenth Ward. She was long connected with All Souls Universalist Church and was before her marriage a teacher in the Sunday School of that congregation. She was active in church affairs during the pastorate of the Rev. Dr. Almon Gunnison, who officiated at her wedding. Mrs. Lyon was a member of the Portia Club and for some time its secretary, and was also a member of the Wadleigh Association, composed of graduates of the Wadleigh High School of Manhattan. She is survived by her husband, formerly connected with the Williamsburg Fire Insurance Company, now retired; a son, Frank F. Lyon of Pittsburg, Pa., a daughter, Amy, the wife of Walter D. Pheteplace of Heidelberg, Germany; a sister, Mrs. W. B. Cottrell of San Francisco, Cal., and five grandchildren.
