DEATH LIST OF A DAY

Miss Margaret Macvey, daughter of the late Amnon Macvey, who was for thirty-five years Superintendent of Buildings of the Board of Education, died on Friday last at her home, 143 West Tenth Street, after a lingering illness. She was born in New York in 1821, and had been a life-long resident of the Ninth Ward. She was a member of the Universalist Church, and the funeral services, which were held last evening, were conducted by the Rev. Edwin C. Bolles, of the Church of Eternal Hope [Third Universalist]. The burial will be at Greenwood Cemetery.
