The remains of Mrs. Julius Madison who passed away in Rochester were brought to Victor and funeral services were held in the mortuary of R. C. Emery & Co. Monday, the Rev. Nelson L. Lobdell [Universalist] officiating. Mrs. Madison, who for some time conducted hairdressing parlors here, was for many years a resident of Victor and was held in high regard by many friends. She had lived in Rochester for quite a number of years.

There are no near relatives surviving. Mr. Madison, who was a Civil War veteran, died in Victor many years ago [in 1917], and an only son Chester passed away in Rochester about a year ago. Burial was made in the family lot in Boughton Hill cemetery.
