EARL MANCLOW DIES AT 89

Earl W. Manclow, 89, of 82 Reid St., Fort Plain, died Thursday noon at the Canajoharie Nursing Home, where he had been a patient for two years.

He was born Dec. 11, 1880, in the Brookman's Corners section of the Town of Minden, the son of Joseph and Sarah Sneck Manclow, and had been a lifelong area resident.

Prior to retiring he had been self-employed as a carpenter for over 50 years. Mr. Manclow attended the Universalist Church of the Messiah.
