Oliver C. Marsh

Fort Plain, June 25.—Oliver C. Marsh, aged over 79 years, died at his home on Spring street in this village, at 6:30 o'clock last evening. He has been ill for a number of years but had only been confined to his bed for a week. Mr. Marsh was born in the town of Minden and had been a resident of Fort Plain nearly his entire life. He was a veteran of the Civil war, enlisting with Company B, Twenty-fourth New York cavalry. Mr. Marsh was a member of Klock post, No. 70, G.A.R. He is survived by his wife [Maria L. Sparks Marsh], one son and a daughter, Nicholas Marsh and Mrs. William [Cora] Morgan, of this village. The funeral will be held at the Catherine Nellis Memorial chapel Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, the Rev. Herbert Frank Moulton, of the Universalist church, officiating. The interment will be in Fort Plain cemetery.
