—William Martin, familiarly known as “gunsmith” Martin, died suddenly Monday morning, March 26. He had been in feeble health for some time. He was an eccentric character. About forty years ago he was an active member of the Universalist organization then in existence here, and preached regularly for some time in the building, which formerly stood near the present site of L. J. Jones’ tin shop, which burned in the fall of 1882.
