FORMER WELL KNOWN NURSE PASSES AWAY  
MRS. ELLEN M'BRIDE, 86, HAS BEEN IN FAILING HEALTH FOR MANY MONTHS

Mrs. Ellen McBride, widow of Al McBride, who for many years was well known as a nurse in this city, died early this morning at the family residence, 333 West Lynde street, aged 86 years. She had been in failing health for several months and had been confined to her bed since early in December. She passed away at 6:10 this morning. Death was due to old age, heart trouble and other complications.

Mrs. McBride was born in Montreal, Canada and came to this section as a child. She had spent the greater part of her life in Watertown and vicinity and was well known here. For many years she was nurse to prominent families in Watertown, caring for the children and for those who were taken ill.

Besides her daughter, Mrs. Jennie Reddick, who made her home with Mrs. McBride, she leaves one son, J. Clinton McBride of Syracuse; four grandchildren, and five great-grandchildren. Mrs. McBride has many friends and acquaintances in Syracuse where she had visited frequently with her son, J. Clinton McBride.

Mr. McBride passed away many years ago. Mrs. McBride had retired from her profession as practical nurse during the past 15 or 20 years.

The funeral will be at 2 Tuesday afternoon from the McBride residence, 333 West Lynde street, Rev. Harry Westbrook Reed, D.D., pastor of All Souls Universalist church, officiating. Interment will be in Riverside cemetery, Copenhagen.

Mrs. McBride was an honorary member of the Julia Dent Circle, Woman's Relief Corps and also a member of the North Side improvement League Auxiliary.
