Friendship, May 1. After an illness of several weeks, Mrs. Catherine McCormick passed away Sunday morning [April 25] at her home on East Main St. Catherine Scott McCormick, daughter of Martin and Abigail Scott [illegible] Friendship November 12, 1842, and had spent her entire life in this village. She was a member of the first graduating class of the old academy. She was an earnest and conscientious member and worker of the Universalist church, and a member of the O.E.S., who attended her funeral in a body. She is survived by one brother, R. A. Scott, of this village who, with his wife, resided with her at the family homestead. The funeral services were held at the house Tuesday afternoon [April 27] at 2:30, conducted by her former pastor, Rv. W. [Wm.] G. Cortright, of Cortland, N.Y.

Dr. F. T. Munson very feelingly rendered that beautiful solo, "One Sweetly, Solemn Thought." There were many beautiful flowers sent in memory of the departed one. Burial at Maple Grove cemetery.
