MRS. POLLY S. M'DONALD PASSES AWAY SUDDENLY

CARTHAGE, Nov. 17.—The funeral of Mrs. Polly Sarvey McDonald will be held from her home in Bridge street, West Carthage, at 2 o'clock Monday afternoon. Burial will be in Fairview Cemetery. Rev. G. D. [George Delbert] Walker [Universalist] and Rev. N. A. Fuller [pastor of the United Christian Church] will officiate.

Mrs. McDonald died suddenly at her home at 2:30 Friday morning. She attended the fashion show at the Strand theatre with her husband, C. P. McDonald. She was apparently in fine physical condition. On returning home she complained of not feeling well and started to go upstairs. She fell on the top step, having suffered from a shock [a stroke]. Dr. C. F. Adams was summoned, also a trained nurse, but she failed to rally. She was born in the town of Wilna May 4, 1858, the daughter of the late Charles and Phila Sarvey.

On October 4, 1877 she was married to C. P. McDonald, who survives, with one half-brother, Lott Sarvey, of Waterloo, Ia.
