T J. McDONALD DIES AT FRIENDSHIP

FRIENDSHIP, Oct. 11.—Theodore Jennings McDonald, 82, died suddenly at his home on West Water street, Sunday morning, from a heart attack.

Mr. McDonald was born in Sharon Center, Pa., June 15, 1852, and had resided in this village for more than 15 years.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Harriet Hitchcock McDonald; two stepdaughters, Miss Wilna M. Hitchcock, Friendship; Mrs. Clifford Herrick of Nile, and one brother, Charles McDonald of Caledonia.
