The funeral of Frederick McIntyre, who died from heart trouble at his home in Oswego Falls, occurred this afternoon from the Universalist church. He was forty-seven years old. A post-mortem examination showed the vital organs in such a condition as to make it a wonder that he had survived as long as he did. The Rev. A. U. Hutchins, formerly of this village, but now located at Syracuse, conducted the funeral service, assisted by the Rev. B. Brunning. Burial was made at Mount Adnah cemetery. Both sons of the deceased, John and Jedediah, reached his bedside before death.
