R. B. MERRILL DIES AT HOME

Funeral services for Robert B. Merrill, 48, Troop K Rd., Manlius, who died June 27 at his home, were held Monday at the Newell-Tellman Funeral Home in Manlius, the Rev. Jack Buskey officiating. Burial was in Manlius Cemetery.
