

[Mickle, Rose Eckler]

[Herkimer—] A well known and highly esteemed woman passed to rest yesterday afternoon when the death of Mrs. Michael Mickle occurred at her home, 119 First Avenue, at 4 p.m. She had been ill for some time, and two months ago suffered a second stroke of paralysis, from which she failed to make a recovery, having previously sustained a stroke three years ago.

Mrs. Rose Eckler Mickle was born in the town of Stark, 60 years ago, and about forty years ago married Michael Mickle. They lived in that vicinity until (12?) years ago when they took up their residence in this village. She was a devoted and faithful attendant of the Universalist Church as long as her health would permit.

Besides the husband there survive to mourn her loss one son, Floyd Mickle of this village; three brothers, George Eckler of Fort Plain, Horatio Eckler of Van Hornesville, and William Eckler of Little Falls, and one sister, Mrs. John Maxfield of Little Falls. The funeral will be held Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock from the late home, Rev. L. [Lewis] H. Robinson officiating, with interment in Oak Hill Cemetery.
