The funeral of James L. Miller took place yesterday at Dr. [Edwin] Chapin's Church [Church of the Divine Paternity; Fourth Universalist] at Fifth-avenue and Forty-fifth-st. The coffin was borne from the late residence of the deceased man, No. 115 East Fifty-fifth-st., to the church, and was followed by a long line of mourners. The funeral services were conducted by Dr. Chapin, and the remains were taken to Woodlawn Cemetery. Mr. Miller was a well-known architect, and was President of the Hoboken Turtle Club and the Sparta Club.
