MRS. EMMA B. MISSION

The death of Mrs. Emma Ball Mission occurred at Thanksgiving Hospital at noon, Sunday, March 31st. On the previous Sunday she had undergone an operation for gall stones, but a tumor was found, and her condition was considered almost hopeless from the time the operation was performed. Mrs. Mission was born 73 years ago and had lived her entire life in this vicinity. She and her husband celebrated their golden wedding anniversary at their home on Lake street about five years ago. The deceased was a member of the Universalist church and a woman highly esteemed in this community. She is survived by her husband and one daughter, Anna, of this village, besides other relatives. The funeral was held Wednesday afternoon at three o'clock at her late home on Lake street, the Rev. William G. Cortright officiating. Interment was made in Lakewood cemetery.
