SUDDEN DEATH IN MACEDON OF MRS. SARAH MITCHELL

Macedon, August 8.—Mrs. Sarah Mitchell, wife of William Mitchell, died at her home in this village Wednesday night, August 2nd, following a week's illness of heart trouble. Sarah Bradley was born in Macedon, August 29, 1846. Her parents were Silas Bradley and Mary J. Moore Bradley. On December 1, 1870, she married William Mitchell, and the greater part of her wedded life had been spent in this town. Three children were born to them, all passing away in early childhood. Mrs. Mitchell was a woman of remarkable energy. Many years ago she identified herself with the Universalist church here and was also a charter member of Eureka Chapter, Order of Eastern Star, and had held the office of Electa for nine years. She was also a member of the W.R.C. of Fairport. The funeral service took place from her late home Saturday afternoon at 2:30 and from the Universalist church at 3 o'clock. Dr. Samuel G. Ayres of Woonsocket, Rhode Island, was the officiating clergyman. The Woman's Relief Corps of Fairport acted as an escort. Burial was made in the village cemetery and the members of Eureka Chapter, O.E.S., conducted the service of their order at the grave. Besides her husband, the near relatives are one sister, Mrs. Evaline Parmington of Rochester; two nephews, George and Samuel Parmington; one niece, and seven grand-nieces, all of Rochester.
