Joseph Morgan

The people of this vicinity realize that they have lost a good citizen and a kind neighbor since Joseph Morgan was called from earthly labor on December 31st. Mr. Morgan was born in Wales, B. I., in 1841. Before he was one year old his parents moved to Russia, Herkimer county, where he spent most of his young manhood and where he married Miss Anne Cumming of Ohio, Herkimer county. While he lived there he was a guide in the Adirondacks and was well known to many famous sportsmen. Naturally he was proud of the fact that Grover Cleveland chose him of all others for his personal guide when he hunted on these grounds.

In 1883 he moved with his family to Wisconsin and returned in 1904 to this place and bought the Sliter farm near Allen's Lake, which has ever since been his home. He was known by all as a scrupulously honest man, and in every transaction honorable. His neighbors sincerely mourn his demise. He leaves of his immediate family his widow, Mrs. Anne Morgan, and a daughter, Mrs. Stanley Sheridan of this place. The funeral was held at the home of the deceased on Monday, January 3rd, Rev. L. [Lewis] H. Robinson of the Universalist church officiating. Mrs. Morgan will now make her home with Mrs. Sheridan in this village.
