Mrs. Caroline L. [I.] Morton Dies at Her Home Today

Mrs. Caroline L. [I.] Morton, 415 Roberts street, died at her home at 1 o'clock this morning after an illness extending over the past eight years. For the greater part of this time she has been confined to her bed.

Mrs. Morton was born in Lee, 78 years ago, daughter of the late Augustine and Cornelia Putnam Potter. She was married there to Henry C. Morton who died about 20 years ago [in 1907]. She had lived in Rome for about 25 years. She was a member of the Universalist church.
