Mrs. Howard Morts

Mrs. Howard Morts, a very highly respected resident of Mohawk died Dec. 7. Mrs. Morts had been ill since last August, death being caused by complications. She was born in Mohawk June 4, 1852, a daughter of Herman and Jane Bliss. Her marriage to Howard Morts took place Feb. 12, 1873. She had always lived in Mohawk and vicinity and was an attendant of the Universalist Church. She was dearly loved by her friends and many regret to hear of her passing.

Besides her husband, she is survived by four daughters, Mrs. Eugene Knapp of Stratford, N.Y.; Mrs. Burton Fineout of Little Falls, Mrs. Jane Davis and Miss Ola Morts, who lives at home. The funeral was held privately Wednesday afternoon, Rev. Mr. [Frank] Hokerk of the Universalist church of Herkimer officiating. Burial was made in the Mohawk cemetery.
