EDWARD S. MOYER

Dolgeville, March 12—Following an illness of about six years, Edward S. Moyer died yesterday afternoon at his home on Slauson Street, due to a complication of diseases.

Mr. Moyer was born in Minden, Aug. 24, 1859, and was a son of the late Elias and Margaret Getman Moyer. His afther [sic] was the first carpenter to work in this village for Alfred Dolge. He was married in 1871 to Katherine Snell. All of their married life, except two years in St. Johnsville, was spent in this village. He was employed by the Daniel Green Felt Shoe Company for 42 years, until ill health compelled his retirement.

He was a member of the Universalist Church. Surviving are the wife; two daughters, Mrs. Byron Ogden of this village and Mrs. Arthur Halstead of Cortland; a sister, Mrs. Helen Getman of Gloversville; and four grandchildren. The funeral will be held from the family home at 1:30 Wednesday afternoon. The Rev. C. A. Moulton of the Universalist Church will officiate and the remains will be placed in the vault of the Inghams Mills Cemetery.
