MRS. HATTIE MOYER DIES AT DOLGEVILLE; STROKE PROVES FATAL

Dolgeville, Oct. 9—Mrs. Hattie Moyer died yesterday afternoon at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Leonard Timmerman, on Howard Street. She was stricken with paralysis a month ago.

She was born in Salisbury Center, Sept. 2, 1855 and was the daughter of Reuben and Barbara Bloodough Foster. She was married to Albert Moyer, whose death occurred five years ago, since which time he had made her home here with her daughter.

She was a member of the Salisbury Center Universalist Church, the Rebekah Lodge of this village and the American Legion Auxiliary here. Mrs. Moyer is survived by five children, Mrs. Clark Ingersoll and Mrs. Leonard Timmerman of this village, Mrs. Eugene Johnson of Ingham Mills, Arthur Moyer of New Bedford, Mass., and Charles Youker of Inghams Mills.

The funeral will be held from the home of Mrs. Timmerman at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon, the Rev. C. A. Moulton of the Universalist Church officiating. Burial will be made at Salisbury Center.
