FORT PLAIN—J. Wesley Moyer, 74, a well known farmer of the Dutchtown section of this town, died Tuesday evening at his home after an illness of six weeks. Deceased was a son of Jacob and Margaret Bauder [Moyer] and born in the Dutchtown section. Mr. Moyer was a director of the Farmers' Insurance Company of the Town of Minden and at one time was highway commissioner of this town. In politics he was a Republican. He was twice married, his first wife, who was Anna Moyer, a daughter of Chauncey and Mary Moyer, and died five years ago. He was married a couple of years ago to Mrs. Alice Lambert Wright, who survives, together with two sons, Jacob and Chauncey of this place; two daughters, Mrs. Mary Nellis, of Fort Plain; Mrs. Flora Saltsman, Utica; also several grandchildren. Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2 at the home, Rev. R. [Rufus] H. Dix, pastor of the Universalist church, officiating. Remains placed in the Catherine Nellis Memorial Chapel vault until spring, when burial will be made in the Fort Plain cemetery.
