SAMUEL MOYER, AGED RESIDENT OF DEXTER, DEAD WAS NINETY.TWO YEARS OF AGE, AND RESIDED 72 YEARS IN DEXTER.

Dexter, Dec. 7.—Samuel Moyer died at the home of his son, William, in this place Sunday, at 2, having been stricken by a shock [stroke] Oct. 13, and since that time had been slowly failing. He was born in Fairfield, Herkimer county, March 20, 1822. Mr. Moyer came to Dexter in March, 1842, where he married Miss Abigal [Abigail] Frost in 1844. She died about 18 years ago. He learned the blacksmith trade here, and worked at that trade for a number of years, when he went [to] farming, which he continued until about 30 years ago, when he retired. Since the death of his wife he had made his home with his son, where he died.

He is survived by two sons, William and James, both of this place, and two grandsons.

The funeral will be held Tuesday afternoon, Dec. 8, at 2, at the house, Rev. Harry Westbrook Reed [Universalist] officiating. Burial in the Dexter cemetery.
