CENTRAL SQUARE, Dec. 9.—Mrs. Mary Munsell, 95, died at her home in South Main street Thursday morning, having been in failing health many months.

Mrs. Munsell, daughter of Hopestill and Elmira Sparks Hall, was born in Central Square Jan. 7, 1837. She was twice married, her first husband losing his life in the Civil War. Later she married Giles Munsell who has been dead about 30 years.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Josephine Rogers, eight grandchildren, six great grandchildren and one great great grandchild.
