C. L. MUNSON, 26, LONG ILL, DIES
WATERTOWN MAN VICTIM OF TUBERCULOSIS
WAS FORMER DEXTER ATHLETE

Until Stricken Two Years Ago He Worked at Jefferson County
Savings Bank—Member of Watertown Masons

C. Lynn Munson, 26, 466 Flower avenue east, well known young man of Dexter and Watertown and former star baseball and basketball player at Dexter High school, died at the family home this morning following an illness of two years. Death was attributed to tuberculosis. Mr. Munson worked at one time for the Jefferson County Savings Bank.

Mr. Munson was born Oct. 25, 1901 at Dexter, the only son of Bruce A. and Bessie E. Bayley Munson. He had to resign his position with the bank a few years ago and go to Saranac Lake for treatment. When he returned to Watertown his family made their home in this city.

He was a member of Watertown Lodge, F. and A. M. and a member of the Dexter Universalist church. He was educated in the public schools of Dexter and Brownville and was a graduate of the Northern New York Business College. He is survived by his father and mother.

Funeral services will be held from the late home at 2 Sunday afternoon with services at the Dexter Universalist church at 2:30, Rev. Harry Westerbrook Reed, pastor of All Souls Universalist church of Watertown, officiating. Burial will be in Dexter. The Masonic order will have charge of the services at the grave.
