DEATHS.

In this city [Utica], August 31st, EPHRAIM, only son of Edmund Munson, in the 7th year of his age. In the wise providence of God, this family has been severely afflicted with illness. The sole surviving parent was lying very low with the same illness, at the time his son was removed, as the son had been when the mother was called away—and the two other children have also been ill, one night unto death.
