FORMER PLUMBER IS FALL VICTIM
H. D. Myers, Who Plunged Down Stairs a Week Ago,
Dies in City Hospital —Was 65

H. D. Myers, 65, of Fleming, former Auburn plumber, died Monday afternoon at Auburn City Hospital as the result of injuries he suffered on December 10 when he fell while descending a flight of stairs at a Genesee Street building. Mr. Myers worked as a plumber in Auburn for many years, and was latterly with Smith & Pearson. An infection forced the amputation of a leg about four and one-half years ago, and since that time Mr. Myers had made his home with a brother and sister, Ray Myers and Miss Sarah Myers, in Fleming. He was known as an expert on hunting dogs. Surviving him besides the brother and sister are his wife, Mrs. Georgia Smith Myers, and another brother, Algee S. Myers, both of Fleming. Funeral services will be held at 2:30 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at Langham's Funeral Home, 91 East Genesee Street, with Rev Hal T. Kearns, pastor of the First Universalist Church, officiating. Burial will be in Fleming Rural Cemetery.
