MRS. C. R. NASH

On Wednesday afternoon, April 22d, Mrs. C. R. Nash died at her home on Sanger street, in this village, of capillary bronchitis at the age of 63 years. Her illness was short, only a brief week elapsing between the first attack of the fatal disease and her death. The deceased was born in the town of Brookfield, her maiden name being Prudence Terry. In 1841 she married Clark R. Nash and they took up their residence in Hubbardsville where they lived until eleven years ago when they moved to Waterville. She had been a member of the Universalist church of Hubbardsville for many years. Besides her husband she leaves two brothers, Charles Terry, Sr., of Florida, and Morris Terry, of Waterville, and four children, C. DeAlton Nash, of North Brookfield; F. D. Nash, an attorney of Tacoma, Wash.; and Mrs. A. E. Wood and Miss Clara Nash, of Waterville.
