Wethersfield

Died, at his father's residence in Wethersfield, from the effects of cancer of the jaw and tongue, Franklin B. Neely. He had been a sufferer ever since last December, and about four months since the physicians pronounced his disease a cancer. He had been failing for some time, and Saturday evening, June 28, he died. He was born in Fairfield, Herkimer county, N.Y., Oct. 5, 1883, and moved to this town fifty-four years ago. Since then he has been a farmer, hotel-keeper, groceryman, and a manufacturer of saleratus. For the past ten or fifteen years he has been able to do but little work, and has lived on the old homestead farm, which has been carried on by his oldest son, Frank. The deceased leaves a wife [Almira Griswold Neely] and five children. The funeral services were held at the house on Monday afternoon, and were conducted by Rev. [S. A.] Whitcomb [Universalist] of Perry. The remains were placed in the cemetery at this place.
