Obituary Notes.

Walter Nelson, a well known and respected resident of this city, died Sunday afternoon at the home of his son, Eugene, 605 East Gansevoort street. Mr. Nelson was born on November 10, 1840, at the old Nelson homestead in the town of Little Falls and was the son of John and Jeannette Nelson, the family being pioneer settlers of that section. Mr. Nelson conducted a farm for many years, and in later life he went into the grocery business with W. F. Spohn in the store at the corner of Main and Mary streets. He was a kind hearted man, with generous impulses and faithful and true. He is survived by two sons, Eugene and John Nelson of this city; by six grandchildren, and by seven great-grandchildren; also by two nieces, residing in Newport. The funeral will be held from the home of Eugene Nelson at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon, Rev. H. M. Cary of the Universalist church officiating, and will be private. Friends wishing to view the remains may do so between the hours of 7 and 9 o'clock Tuesday evening.
