Obituary.

Died in the town of Cuba, April 7th, Mrs. H. B. Newton, in the 70th year of her age. She was the oldest child of the late Sears Smalley of our town and sister of Abner, Andrew, [and] Charles Smalley and Mrs. Hicks. She was married to Mr. H. B. Newton, of Bolivar, April 14th, 1858. One son and three daughters were the result of this union. The children are all married and settled in life and were able to minister to the wants of one of the kindest and best of mothers during her last sickness and death. She was a quiet, peaceful woman, a kind neighbor, and true and faithful in all the relations of life. The same clergyman (Rev. F. M. [Francis Milton] Alvord) [Universalist] who officiated at her wedding 36 years ago, was called upon to officiate at her funeral which was held at the residence of her son, Hollis, where she died. The choir of the Universalist church rendered some very appropriate and consoling music. Interment in Maple Grove cemetery.
