Pioneer Farmer of County, James M. Nicholson, Passes Away

James M. Nicholson, a life-long resident and prominent Democrat of the town of Royalton, passed away at his home on the Mountain Ridge road shortly before noon today. He was in his 85th year. He leaves his wife, Mary E. Nicholson, one son, Frank Nicholson of Niagara Falls, and one daughter, Mrs. Carrie Dale, at home. The funeral services will be held Monday afternoon at 4 o'clock at his late residence on the Mountain Ridge road, Rev. E. H. Carritt [Universalist] of Middleport officiating. Burial will be in Mountain Ridge cemetery.

Mr. Nicholson was born in the southern part of the town of Royalton, and for many years was a farmer on the Griswold road in that town. He was always a staunch Democrat in political affairs, and spent many years in the service as town assessor and road commissioner. He retired from farming several years ago.
