## Edward W. Nichoson

Edward Walsworth Nichoson passed away at his home at Murray on Tuesday, April 18, 1933.

He was born on April 30, 1851, the son of Dr. Robert R. Nichoson and Cornelia A. Nichoson. He was the youngest of four sons. A descendant of one of the first families to settle in this section, he spent a happy boyhood here.

On November 15, 1876 he married Miss Annie E. Bassett of Kendall [daughter of William R. and Olive Munger Bassett] who passed away February 2, 1931.

For many years Mr. Nichoson resided in Rochester where he was connected with the American Express Company. He returned to Murray in 1925 and took much pride and enjoyment in going back to the old farm.
