DEATH OF WILLIAM H. NICKASON

William H. Nickason, 84 years of age and formerly one of Auburn's best known carpenters, died at 11 o'clock this morning at the home of his daughter, Mrs. H. Jay Walker, in the town of Owasco. Mr. Nickerson had been ill for the past eight months.

As one of Auburn's carpenters, Mr. Nickason took a hand in construction of the Auburn High School, the First Baptist Church and many business blocks and residences of this city. He was born in the town of Conquest, coming to Auburn when a boy. He lived in Auburn up until three years ago when he went to Owasco to make his home with his daughter.

He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. H. Jay Walker of Owasco, and by one son, Fred H. Nickason of this city. The funeral will be held Sunday afternoon at the home of his daughter. The services will be conducted by Rev. H. M. Cary, pastor of the First Universalist Church. Burial will be made in Soule Cemetery.
