FRANK NICKERSON

Frank Nickerson, former resident who had made his home in this community most of his life, died at the Herkimer hospital Wednesday morning of complications. He had been in the hospital for about six weeks. Mr. Nickerson was born September 12, 1873 in Rockwood and was the son of the late Charles and Josephine Nickerson. About seventeen years ago he moved to Ilion and has been unable to work at his trucking business for some time. He at one time was a fireman and watchman for the New York Central Railroad. In Little Falls [on] July 4, 1904 he married Elenor [Eleanor] Voorhees who died about three years ago. He was a twenty-five year member of the I.O.O.F. in this village.

The survivors are two sons, Harry of this village and Cpl. Charles of Seibert, Alabama; two daughters, Mrs. Sadie Armstrong of Pittsburg, California, and Mrs. Estella Sadolski of Herkimer at whose home he had been living since the death of his wife.

The funeral will be held this afternoon at 2 from the Jacobson funeral home; the Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton of the Universalist church will officiate. The body will be placed in the vault of the local cemetery to await burial in the spring.
