MRS. NILES, MINISTER'S WIFE, DIES

Canton — Mrs. Hildred Orr Niles, 65, wife of Rev. Dr. Harold H. Niles, who was pastor of All Souls Universalist Church in Watertown for seventeen years, died at the Edward John Noble Hospital in Canton at 8 a.m. May 16. She had been a patient for three days.

The body was removed to the Lawrence Funeral Home at Canton for visiting hours Sunday, and funeral services were held at 2:30 p.m. Monday from All Souls Church in Watertown. Dr. John E. Woods, pastor of the All Souls officiated, assisted by Dr. Max A. Kapp of the St. Lawrence University Theological School and the Rev. Dr. Ellsworth Reamon of Syracuse. Burial will be in the Enosburg Center Cemetery, Vermont.

In addition to her husband, Dr. Harold H. Niles, she is survived by three sons, Rev. Albert C. Niles, Pike Road, Canton, a member of the Theological School faculty at St. Lawrence University; Nathan O. Niles, a member of the mathematics department staff at the United States Naval Academy, Annapolis, Maryland; and Richard P. Niles, Brooklyn; two sisters, Mrs. Philip Stanley of Enosburg Falls, Vermont, and Mrs. Jack Cowan, Oakhurst, California.

Mrs. Niles was born Oct. 24, 1893 at Hemmingford, Quebec, a daughter of the late Albert J. and Emily Cushman Orr and graduated from the high school there in 1912. She later attended the New York State School of Agriculture and Domestic Science at Canton from 1912-13. On Aug. 4, 1915, she married the Rev. Dr. Harold H. Niles at Enosburg Center, Vermont.
