Mrs. Bertie B. Noble, 84, Dies

Widow of Great Lakes Ship Captain Expires at Ellisburg—Rites Tuesday

Belleville, Jan. 23—Mrs. Bertie Bemis Noble, 84, widow of Charles Noble, former Great Lakes ship captain, died Sunday evening at 6 at the Chrisman Nursing Home, where she had been a patient since the summer of 1948.

Funeral services will be held with Rev. Herbert H. Hartson, pastor of Sandy Creek Methodist church officiating. Burial will be in Rural cemetery, Ellisburg.

Born in the town of Ellisburg Jan. 24, 1865, daughter of Marshall J. and Eliza McKee Bemis, she was married to Charles H. Noble in Ellisburg Jan. 2, 1884. They celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in 1944 and in April of that year, Mr. Noble died.

Mrs. Noble was a past noble grand of Belleville Rebekah Lodge; past chairman of the Ellisburg home bureau; a former member of the Universalist church at Ellisburg [which was closed by Nov. 1945] and a member of the Willing Workers class of the Ellisburg Methodist church.

Surviving are one brother, Pardon Bemis of Babylon, L.I., and four nieces, Mrs. Hugh (Barbara) Killam, Sandy Creek; Mrs. Warren (Esther) Walker, Syracuse; Mrs. Rodney (Winifred) Sanford, Brooklyn; and Mrs. Floyd (Alma) Lee, Adams R. D.
