—Miss Adelaide J. Norris, 52, died at her home in Potsdam at 4:30 o'clock last Tuesday morning. She spent four months this year at the sanatorium at Clifton Springs, N. Y. Miss Norris was graduated from the Potsdam State Normal, class of '83, and accepted a position at Mount Kisco. She taught there three years, later accepting a position in the Minneapolis city schools for three years. Miss Norris was appointed principal of the Mount Kisco free school a few years later. Afterward she came to the Potsdam Normal School and had charge of the intermediate department. Miss Norris for seventeen years had been a member of the faculty of the Potsdam State Normal School. She was principal of the intermediate department during this long period. The funeral was held at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon in the Normal Hall. She was a member of the Universalist Church, and Rev. D. L. Fisher, pastor of that society, conducted the services. One brother, Irving Norris, of Crarys Mills, survives.
