Miss Lydia J. North, a lifelong and highly esteemed resident of Victor, died in the F. F. Thompson Hospital in Canandaigua, Thursday afternoon, December 18, 1941. She was taken to the hospital Thursday morning, after having been confined to her bed for a few days, but she had been in failing health for several years.

Miss North was a daughter of James Byron and Jane Eliza Ellis North. She was born on the farm now occupied by Mrs. Frank North and family, and with the exception of a few years in Canandaigua, she had lived in Victor township throughout her life. When failing health forced her to give up her home in Covill street, which she had enjoyed for quite a number of years, she went to make her home with Mrs. Harry North and family south of Victor village. She was a devoted member of St. Paul's Universalist parish, and was held in high esteem by many friends. She was the last of her generation of the North family, and is survived by two nieces and three nephews.

Funeral services will be conducted at the home of Mrs. Harry North at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon. Interment will be in the Boughton Hill Cemetery.
