Mrs. Cordelia Norton, wife of the late Clayton Norton, a former resident of Canisteo, died at St. James Hospital in Hornell yesterday morning, following an illness of three weeks from apoplexy. She was born in South Dansville 64 years ago, and came to Canisteo at the time of her marriage 45 years ago. After the death of her husband she resided in New York and in Buffalo for 20 years, and 3 years ago returned to Canisteo to live. She was a woman of unusual ability, and was highly esteemed and respected. She leaves many friends to whom her death is a severe shock.

She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. P. A. Powers of this village, two brothers, Charles Robinson of Canisteo and Adelbert Robinson of Hornell, and three sisters, Mrs. M. J. Clark of Lodi, Wis., Mrs. E. Maricle of Pembroke, N.Y., and Mrs. L. Norton of Hornell. The funeral will be held from the residence at 2:30 p.m. tomorrow, Rev. [Clara] Morgan, the woman pastor of the Universalist church of Perry, officiating. Burial will be made in Hope Cemetery, Hornell.
